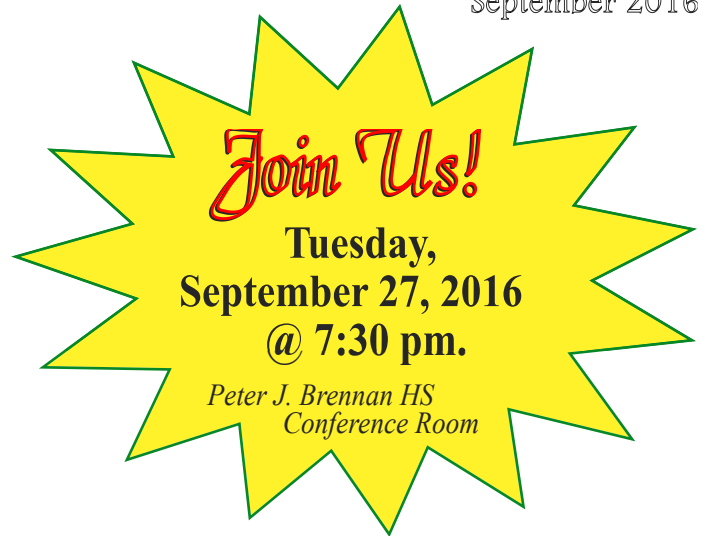

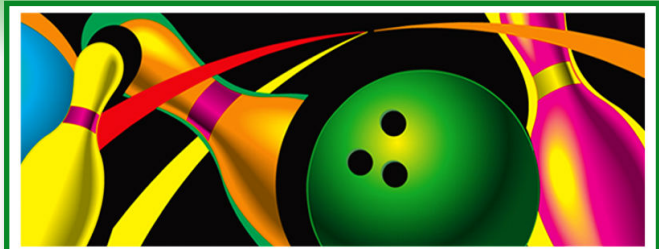
Tips on How to Help your Child Succeed
