Library Budget VOTE ... APRIL 5, 2016!

Who can vote? . . . Anyone who is:

- 1. A citizen of the United States
- 2. At least 18 years of age
- 3. A resident of the North Babylon School District for a period of 30 days preceding the election.

Who is registered: All persons who were registered for and who voted in any North Babylon School or Library election within four years prior to April 5, 2016 are eligible to vote in this election. Any district resident who is qualified to vote in general elections and who remains qualified to vote from the residence address from which he registered and who has voted in a general election within the last four years is qualified to vote in the library election.

Absentee Ballots:

- 1. Obtain an application in person at the Library or call and the Library will mail one to you.

- 4. Return the signed ballot by April 4, 2016.
